

ORDINANCE #933

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING UNOPPOSED CANDIDATES IN THE MAY 4TH, 2019 GENERAL CITY ELECTION, ELECTED TO OFFICE; CANCELING THE ELECTION; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the general city election was set for May 4th, 2019 for the purpose of electing members to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Secretary has certified in writing that no person has made a declaration of write-in candidacy, and that each candidate on the ballot is unopposed for election to office; and

WHEREAS, under these circumstances, Subchapter C, Chapter 2, Election Code, authorizes the City Council to declare the candidates elected to office and cancel the election.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it Ordained by the City Council if the City of Anson, Texas;

SECTION 1.

The following candidates, who are unopposed in the May 4th, 2019 general City election, are declared elected to office, and shall be issued certificates of election following the time the election would have been canvassed:

<u>Office Sought</u>	<u>Candidate</u>
Alderman Place 4	Leticia Hernandez
Alderman Place 5	Robbie Patterson

SECTION 2.

The May 4th, 2019 general City election is canceled, and the City Secretary is directed to cause a copy of this ordinance to be posted on Election Day at the polling place used or that would have been used in the election.

SECTION 3.

This ordinance shall be effective from and after the date of its passage.
