- K. Adjourn.

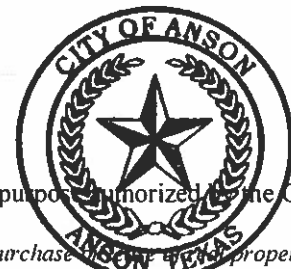
