Call meeting to order and opening prayer

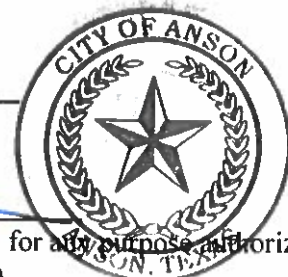
- A. Discuss and take action on the January 13, 2020 Public Hearing minutes.
