SUPPLEMENTAL NOTICE OF MEETING BY VIDEO/TELEPHONE CONFERENCE

In accordance with order of the Office of the Governor issued March 16, 2020, the City Council of the City of Anson will conduct this Special Called Meeting in the City Council Chambers, located at 1301 Commercial Avenue, Anson, Texas by video/telephone conference in order to advance the public health goal of limiting face-to-face meetings (also called "social distancing") to slow the spread of the Coronavirus (COVID-19). The members of the City Council will participate in this meeting either in person or remotely through video conference providing for two-way video and audio communication for each member of the City Council.

There will be no public access to the location described above.

- (c) the written comments must be submitted during or before conclusion of the "**Presentation from Citizens/Public Comment**" agenda item.

Public comments submitted in accordance with the provisions outlined above will be included in the minutes of the meeting.

This meeting will be recorded, and the recording will be available to the public in accordance with the Open Meetings Act upon written request.

- H. Adjourn.

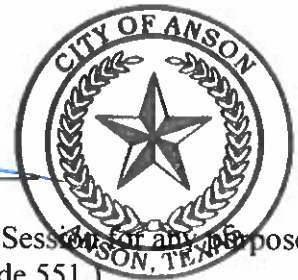
