

- H. Adjourn.

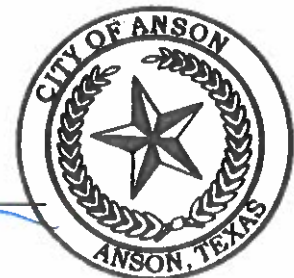
