Notice is hereby given of the City Council of the City of Anson to be held on Monday March 22, 2021, 6:00p.m. at the Anson City Hall, 1301 Commercial Ave, Anson, TX 79501

- A. Discuss and take action on Application to Amend the Zoning Map from Estates Heritage, LLC. requesting that approximately 2.0 acres of land, more or less, located between 2nd Street and 3rd Street and Avenue H and Avenue I on the northeast side of Anson known as Lots 1-14 in Block 3, Chapman Addition to the Town of Anson be rezoned from a MF Multi Family District to a mixed use of MHS Manufactured Housing Subdivision District ("MHS") and SF Single-Family Residential District ("SF").
- B. Discuss and take action on Application to Amend the Zoning Map from Estates Heritage, LLC requesting that approximately 1.0 acres of land, more or less, in various tracts on the northeast side of Anson known as LOTS 3-6, in Block 10 at the northeast corner of 5th Street and Avenue I; Lot 1&2 in Block 7 at the southeast corner of 3rd Street and Avenue I; Lot 2 in Block 8 at the southeast corner of 3rd Street and Avenue H and all of these lots are in the Chapman Addition to the TOWN of Anson and also the lot described as Abstract 777-44 located between 2nd and 3rd Street on Avenue K on the west side in the City of Anson be rezoned from a SF Single-Family Residential District ("SF") to a mixed use of MHS Manufactured Housing Subdivision District and SF District
