- I. Adjourn.

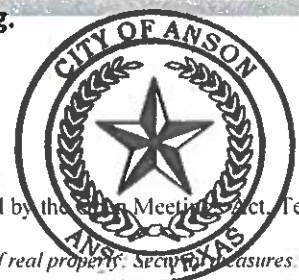
