

- J. Adjourn.

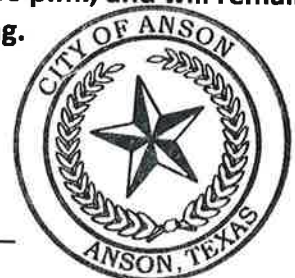
