Notice is hereby given of the City Council of the City of Anson to be held on Monday May 15, 2023, 6:00p.m. at the Anson City Hall, 1301 Commercial Ave, Anson, TX 79501

- A. Regarding an application to amend the zoning map from Blue Cactus Properties requesting that approximately 13.89 acres of land out of Section 1, G.C. &S.F. RR. Company Surveys and Section 2, Block 1, T. & N. O. RR. Company Surveys, located in the northwest section of town near Avenue Q & 2nd Street be rezoned from AO Agriculture Open Space District to a SF Single Family Residential Dwelling District.
- B. Regarding an application to amend the zoning map from Geneva Ramos requesting that approximately 0.4 acres of land, more or less, located on the southeast corner of Avenue O and 8th Street described as Lot 2, BLOCK 83, ORIGINAL TOWN OF ANSON be rezoned from SF Single Family Residential Dwelling District to a mixed use of MHS Manufactured Housing Subdivision District and SF Single-Family Residential District.
- C. Regarding an application to amend the zoning map from Santos and Gabriel Flores requesting that approximately 0.54 acres of land, more or less, located on the northwest corner of Avenue L and 8th Street. described as the southeast quarter of BLOCK 6, J.H. Edmonds Addition of the Town of ANSON be rezoned from SF Single Family Residential Dwelling District to a mixed use of MHS Manufactured Housing Subdivision District and SF Single-Family Residential District.
